A Parish Plan: actions to be taken forward by the Parish Council over the next 5 to 10 years to develop the village in line with everyone's views.

A Neighbourhood Plan: a set of planning policies to guide the development and use of land within the Parish boundaries.

It might not be feasible or affordable to take forward all ideas that result from the survey, and some will require support from the Parish Council and/or Central Bedfordshire Council. The plans will, however, provide an important focus for directing future use of resources, and some initiatives can be taken forward by us, as a community. The plan will provide a combined view of what people in Haynes want for the future, giving a stronger voice to the community.

It is important to note that, without a Parish Plan, we are much less able to influence the location of any new developments in the village.


